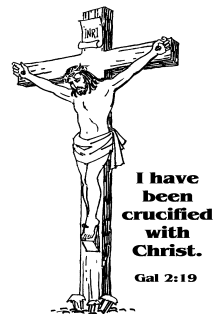

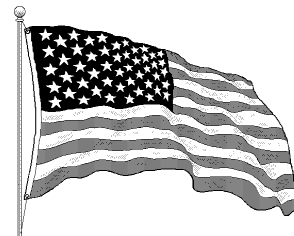


**Holy Hour For Vocations**
