Rt. Rev. Msgr. William I. Ferry, Pastor of St. Sebastian's Parish of Providence, Rhode Island. is proud to announce that construction of a new school for the elementary grades is about to be realized.

The Providence firm of Charles A. Maguire & Associates has been retained to design and engineer the school building which will be located on the corner of Slater Avenue and University Avenue. The former school building which occupied this same site was of wooden construction and has been razed to make room for the new.

The proposed school will be a modern two-story brick building consisting of 9 classrooms, a library, an assembly room, a language laboratory, a lunch room with kitchen facilities, a medical room and administrative offices. The basic construction throughout employs fireproof materials coupled with the latest fire-warning devices to insure maximum safety for the pupils and teachers.

All major areas of operation will have their own control devices in order to provide individual choice of heat requirement.

An exterior wall of each classroom will be composed of glass supported by modern aluminum frames.

The general contractor for the project is the Gilbane Building Company.
