Wow; again I'm very impressed! The initial response to the Outreach Committee March Sandwich Project is **absolutely incredible!** Take a look at it (when you sign up, that is!) at the table in the front vestibule of the Church. Your concern for the hungry just 2 miles from these doors can be described in two words, *Christ like*. Although the ministry begins before Lent, it serves as a good backdrop for our upcoming Lenten discipline. Along those lines, our parish has also donated **\$1,000** from the East Side Market receipts totals of last year to the *Keep the Heat On* program initiated by Bishop Tobin. Keep bringing in your grocery receipts each week and put them in the box near the choir loft stairs. Every receipt earns 1% for our Outreach Program.

Speaking of Lent, the season begins on March 9th. A Lenten schedule will be provided for the season. We will have Benediction and a Lenten Teaching with guest preachers on Sundays at 6:00 pm; Stations of the Cross with music on Mondays, and Parish Penance Service including Penance for our First Communion Class on Sunday, April 3rd. Daily Mass will be at 7:00am.


Today's First Reading highlights one of the poignant themes of the pro-life movement, "Can a mother forget her baby..." The parish will be collecting loose change in baby bottles for the *Baby Bottle Boomerang* to support pro-life efforts of RI for Life. There will be more details in a few weeks.
