THE ANGELUS PRAYER



Now that the bell has been restored in preparation for the 100th Anniversary, it rings for the *Angelus* daily at 12 noon and 6 pm. The sequence is three groups of three rings each, and ending with nine chimes. The *Angelus Prayer*, recited from the Middle Ages, is traditionally prayed at 6 am, noon, and 6 pm. Here is the prayer for your personal or family use:

V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.

R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

Hail Mary, full of grace,

The Lord is with Thee;

Blessed art thou among women,

And blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

Holy Mary, Mother of God,

Pray for us sinners,

Now and at the hour of our death. Amen

V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

R. Be it done unto me according to thy word.

Hail Mary, etc.

V. And the Word was made Flesh.

R. And dwelt among us.

Hail Mary, etc.

V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.
