

The Sunday Gospels of Lent are wonderful meditations for our lives during this penitential season. The Gospel of John uses water with the woman at the well as a symbol for the gift of life in Christ. In a culture that still is very concerned about living (flowing) water, the Sea of Galilee is the only source. The Jordan River waters the entire county of Israel/Palestine. Its journey ends at the Dead Sea. It is “dead” because there is no outlet...thus it is stagnant with no significant life within...except tourists and those taking mud baths!

The parish is still receiving and welcoming new parishioners and families. For some it's the reason of the “Pope Francis Facto, for others it's due to our hospitality and welcoming community, and for others it is a return to God and the Church. In 2013, 34 families or individuals joined the parish. Whatever the draw or attraction is, our parish life in Christ is the central goal of our Christian lives. Like the woman at the well, we, too, ask for that Christ, the Living Water, to refresh us.

The St. Patrick Day Celebration had 96 people attending (and other supporting it even if unable to attend). The live music by the Jesse Liam Band was a great hit...and they will come back! Special thanks you's for the excellent meal prepared by Dave Belanger assisted by Joe Carter, Ms. Marie, Sheila Jarvis, Judy Presnol, Richard Cardillo, Jaime Carrera and our Confirmation candidates. Great job one and all! There are more events coming...and new faces enjoying them. Possibly *Diez de Mayo!*

Next Sunday we will have the in-pew solicitation for the Catholic Charity Fund Appeal. Our goal for this year is **\$80K**. With everyone making a **truly sacrificial gift** as if to Christ Himself, there will be no difficulty. It will be the only in-pew request for the Charity Drive. Direct solicitation is taking place via the mail. There is always the possibility of request letters and our gift crossing in the mail. Our patience with the diocesan office will be needed in some cases. It will be correct in Christian charity! I thank you for your help and participation in this most important effort off our Church to help meet the needs of so many.

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

These are days of **FAST and ABSTINENCE from meat**. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18-59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence (All Fridays in Lent) All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.
