***The Pastor's Corner***

Two important events in Church history occurred last week: we witnessed the end of the papacy of Pope Benedict XVI, and we celebrated our 2013 Parish Lenten Mission with Fr. Tom Hoar. Both events provided the opportunity to see God's love working in the Church. As we continue the journey, a friend said to me last week, "*We walk by faith, and not by sight...*" (2 Cor. 5:7). Pope Benedict will now be addressed as "His Holiness, Benedict XVI, Pope-Emeritus." Trusting that the Holy Spirit will provide us with the Universal Shepherd we need for this post-modern age, like the Apostles gathered in the Upper Room after the Ascension of the Lord...for now, we wait *and* pray.

This weekend we support with prayer our five baptized brothers and sisters from other Christian Churches who will be received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. They are: **Kenneth Amylon, Michelle Barrett, David Groce, Peter Huarmatuck, and Heidi Ravina.** They will be presented to the parish today at the 11 AM Mass. As they prepare for reception, we keep them in our prayers. May the Lord bring to completion what He has begun in you. Welcome!

Our Lenten journey includes outreach to the homeless and hungry with the March Sandwich Drive. Details are in the bulletin. We needed more sign-up lists due to your wonderful response! Feeding the hungry in this way can be a beautiful family experience. Sign up, and thank you.

Next weekend, Mr. John Barry, Diocesan Secretary for Social Ministry, will be with us to share with us the work that is made possible through the Catholic Charity Fund Appeal. John has been on the front-lines of the whole spectrum of causes that impact the very sustenance of people: right to life, hunger, homelessness, prisons, rehabilitation, hospital ministry, elder and nursing care, and end of life issues. **Our parish goal is \$82K.** Last year with the same goal, we contributed **\$85K** to the ministries of Catholic Charities. We will begin the parish phase in a few weeks. As we contemplate the giving of alms as a Lenten discipline, please consider even a small monthly pledge to increase our support of the Appeal. On behalf of the faces that we will never see or the names will never know that are helped in time of need, I thank you in their name for your response as if to Christ Himself.
