THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Solemnities of the Lord are celebrated throughout the liturgical year. Today we have the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, which highlights the lifting up of Jesus for all the world to see at his crucifixion. You'd heard me say that "there is no such thing as cheap grace." Today, we understand the price of our salvation and redemption. The second reading is actually a hymn from the early Church composed by St. Paul. It is known by the Greek word *kenosis*, the emptiness. "He emptied himself and took the form of a slave...." (Philippians 2:7) Listen for the nuances throughout the Mass. They help us focus on the significance of the feast.

Parish activities begin in earnest: Religious Education, Parish Choir, Babysitting during the 9 am Mass, Children Liturgies on the first Sundays of the month, and Community Events in October.
