***THE PASTOR'S CORNER***

The Church Year returns to Ordinary Time. We'll hear readings of the preaching and healing ministry of Jesus from the Gospel of St. Luke. Today's Gospel took place at the foothills of Mt. Tabor, site of the Transfiguration. There were so few Christians remaining in the town that the key to the small Church was in the custody of a local Muslim family. It's such a beautiful story and one that I hope to ponder anew *in situ*.

I take this occasion and this opportunity to share with the entire parish that our very faithful parishioner, **MARIE LANGLOIS**, a dedicated Parish Trustee since the days of Fr. Robert Randall, has asked to step down after 23 years of service to our parish. Marie will continue to be active in parish life, and will bring her talents to other parochial areas according to her active retirement schedule. Trustees Marie Langlois and Charles (Chip) Rogers have advised me and my three predecessors as members of the parish corporation. I met with Marie and Chip shortly after my appointment in January 2010. Since July 1, 2010, the official date of my term as pastor, they have been supportive, open, dedicated and loyal to the Church, to the parish, and to me.

Marie, you have served this parish and the Diocese with exemplary grace. Words can not express the gratitude and appreciation I have for your wisdom and support. On behalf of the entire parish, I express our sincere thanks for all you have done because of your love of Christ and the Church. May you be blessed for your service here in our parish, for the Catholic Church, and in the local community.

Each parish is a civil corporation in the State of Rhode Island. The Church of St. Sebastian Corporation is comprised of the President, the Most Reverend Thomas J. Tobin; the Vice President, the Most Reverend Robert Evans; the Secretary, Msgr. John Darcy; and two Lay Trustees. After consultation with the Trustees and Parish Finance Council, I have nominated **Catherine Taylor** as the new Lay Trustee. Marie and Catherine have been members of the Parish Finance Council for a number of years. I look forward to your new ministry, Catherine as a Parish Trustee at St. Sebastian's.

So, although we return to so-called Ordinary Time... we see *all things are new in Christ*. Enjoy the week.
