The Solemnity of Christ the King brings the 2011/12 Church Year of Grace to a close. This time last year we were preparing to receive the new edition of the Roman Missal throughout the English speaking world. Fair to say, we 've done pretty well as we get more acquainted with the response...”and with your Spirit!”). I am still transitioning to the new texts. Overall, it wasn't as dramatic or shocking as many expected.

Shocking would be seeing Jesus beaten, bruised, in chains, and crowned with thorns. He's called King...King of the Jews by Pilate at the *Ecco homo* moment (“Behold the King!”). The taunting was biting, sarcastic, blasphemous. May we never forget that there is no cheap grace when it comes to the price of our salvation.

We continue to appreciate the fact that we still see the Suffering Servant among us. Where is He? Over the past year, we continued to care for the sick, to bury the dead, to care for the poor and hungry, the cold and homeless. The Adopt a Family Program, Thanksgiving food donations, deepen our understanding of our faith during this **Year of Faith** (at this writing on 11/16 some 60 people are scheduled to attend). That's where we see Him, but it's only possible with eyes, ears, and hands of faith.

And so, as we conclude a Year of Grace, we look **look to the future** . The single candle next week on an Advent Wreath will again bring light into the darkness. We believe that the Light will never go out...for He is with us, always!

### NEXT WEEKEND

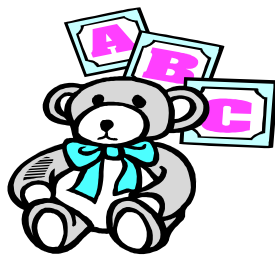
